LEGO wizardry set to bring Harry Potter to life

More than 10,000 people are expected to flock to the Brisbane Showgrounds this weekend to experience some of the most spectacular LEGO displays ever staged nationally.

Created by some of Australia's most passionate and skilled builders, the exhibits include the legendary Blockwarts, plus huge fan-built Harry Potter themed displays from the Hogwarts Express to the Hogwarts Castle and much more.

The two-day BBX LEGO Fan Expo also features the return of the famous Train Group display, a 12-metre square medieval collaboration built from the brand-new Realms Group, the mesmerizing Great Ball Contraption loop from the GBC Team plus massive new models never seen before.

The expo will also highlight more than 200 tables of individual LEGO displays featuring classic LEGO themes, modern creative builds, interactive activities, play tables, special guests, food vendors, retail outlets and more.

Brisbane Showgrounds General Manager of Venue Sales and Marketing Jago Coyle said the expo, now in its 10th year, will be held at the Brisbane Showgrounds for the first time.

"We can't wait to see our Exhibition Building transformed with medieval magic into a LEGO lovers wonderland," Mr Coyle said.

"It will be fantastic to see the venue come alive with more than 80 incredible LEGO displays which are sure to delight people of all ages."

Doors open from 9am-5pm this Saturday and 9am to 4pm this Sunday (Sept 10 & 11).

Entry is \$14 adults, \$7 children and children under 3 years of age are free.
