Good Things bringing international headliners

A bumper lineup of American, UK and Australian rock heavies will descend on the Brisbane Showgrounds this Sunday for Australia's largest travelling music festival Good Things.

Leading the charge at the sold-out festival are American rock idols Fall Out Boy, Limp Bizkit and the iconic Devo, which is bringing their Farewell Tour celebrating 50 Years.

Joining the line-up across the five live music stages will be I Prevail, Bullet for my Valentine, Corey Taylor, Pennywise, Spiderbait, Slowly Slowly, Enter Shikari, Behemoth, Sepultura, Taking Back Sunday; PVRIS, Bloom and Boom Crash Opera.

Also performing are Eskimo Joe, Frenzal Rhomb, Hanabie, Jebediah, Luca Brasi, Magnolia Park, Make Them Suffer, Ocean Sleeper, Royal & The Serpent, Short Stack, Slaughter to Prevail, Stand Atlantic, Tapestry, The Plot In You and While She Sleeps.

The popular music festival has been held at the Showgrounds since it first toured Australia in 2018, bringing forth a new era for Australian alternative music fans.

Around 35,000 people are expected to pack the Showgrounds for the final concert of the east coast festival.

Brisbane Showgrounds General Manager of Venue Sales and Marketing Jago Coyle said he was delighted that the Brisbane leg of Good Things had sold out and the venue was looking forward to hosting another major Australian music festival.

"Good Things is a juggernaut showcase of international alternative music and the latest festival to hit the Showgrounds following Listen Out, Fridayz Live and Post Malone," Mr Coyle said.

"Summer music at the Brisbane Showgrounds continues with Wildlands on New Years Eve and Laneway in February. It's exciting being the hub of Queensland music festivals!" he said.

Good Things is an 18+ event with gates opening at 12pm.
