RNB tour brings music royalty to the Showgrounds

Australia's biggest touring RNB party is bringing a star-studded line-up to the Brisbane Showgrounds this Friday, when it returns after a two year hiatus.

Almost 30,000 people are expected to attend Fridayz Live, featuring 10 of the hottest names in RNB and hip-hop including US megastar and headliner Macklemore, five-time Grammy Award winners TLC and iconic 90s star Shaggy.

The artists will perform nostalgic party hits from the 90s until now, with the event hosted by American rapper Fatman Scoop and Australian television and radio personality Abbie Chatfield.

This is the fifth time the popular music festival has toured Australia and the fourth time since 2017 the Brisbane leg has been held at the Showgrounds.

Brisbane Showgrounds General Manager of Venue Sales and Marketing Jago Coyle said they were looking forward to welcoming international artists to the venue on Friday.

"We've been thrilled to see the return of live music to the Showgrounds following the Covid-19 pandemic and it's fantastic music festivals are once again able to secure big name artists from overseas," Mr Coyle said.

"Our venue has a busy time ahead with the spring / summer music festival season in full swing, with events including Good Things, Wildlands, St Jerome's Laneway and Knotfest to take place between now and March 2023."

Fridayz Live will get underway at 3.30pm, with tickets still available online.
