Fans to level up their skills at gaming and hobby expo at the Brisbane Showgrounds

Australia's ultimate gathering for gamers, hobbyists and model makers will take place at the Brisbane Showgrounds this weekend.

More than 3,000 people are expected to attend the Gaming, Hobby & Model Expo (GhMX) in the Exhibition Building on Saturday and Sunday (22 & 23 November), enjoying a packed program featuring competitive tabletop and card play including Pokémon and Yu-Gi-Oh!, immersive cosplay showcases, hands-on workshops and a scale model building competition.

The event will also feature interactive zones spanning RC racing, esports, Dungeons & Dragons sessions and free-build areas, offering plenty of hands-on experiences for newcomers and seasoned creators.

There is also a live stage program helping visitors to build new skills, including an introduction to figure painting, the basics of 3D printing, using electronics in your builds, and more.

Brisbane Showgrounds General Manager of Venue Sales and Marketing Jago Coyle said it was their third year hosting the popular event.

"We're thrilled to welcome GhMX back to our venue, and to see gamers, makers, creators and families come together for a weekend of imagination and creativity," he said.

"The expo continues to grow each year, and it's wonderful to see such a vibrant community event bring our Exhibition Building to life."

The event will run from 10am to 5pm each day, with tickets available online.
