Boxers fight for a cause at Royal ICC

Amateur boxers will take to the ring at the Royal International Convention Centre (Royal ICC) tomorrow night, for Fight for a Cause.

The event will feature 30 boxers competing across three two minute rounds, raising money for the charity White Cloud Foundation which assists people living with, or at risk, of developing depression and anxiety.

More than 700 people are expected to attend the black tie event, throwing their support behind the beginner boxers who've spent just 10 weeks being put through their paces by world-class trainers.

While cheering on their favourite fighters, guests will enjoy a two-course meal prepared by the Royal ICC's experienced chefs featuring Royal Queensland Awards Gold-medal winning Riverina beef cheek.

Brisbane Showgrounds General Manager of Venue Sales and Marketing Jago Coyle said Fight for a Cause had been held at the Showgrounds since its inaugural event in April last year.

"The event has raised a total of more than \$340,000 for charity and it's definitely an event we're proud to host in our world-class convention centre," Mr Coyle said.

"The versatility of the venue allows us to host a range of events from gala dinners to exhibitions and even boxing matches."

The event gets underway at 6.30pm.
