## Citywide celebration of cycling gears up at the Showgrounds

Australia's largest multi-disciplinary cycling event is returning to the Brisbane Showgrounds this weekend as the Brisbane Cycling Festival presented by King Street, gears up for a three-day citywide event.

The Festival Village will take over the grounds from this Friday as the precinct is transformed as part of the month-long event.

The free pop-up Festival village will welcome thousands of riders and spectators alike who can participate in a range of events and activities with something on offer for cyclists of all abilities.

This includes cycling sessions, bike obstacle courses, bike polo events, street racing events, entertainment on the Main Arena, food, wine, craft beers, and much more.

The Brisbane Cycling Festival, which kicked off on March 15 and runs until April 16, also includes the return of the Australian Unity Tour de Brisbane, AusCycling Track National Championships, Festival Village, Active Lifestyle Expo plus the Oceania Combined Cycling Championships.

Brisbane Showgrounds General Manager of Venue Sales and Marketing Jago Coyle said it is wonderful to be a part of a major community event, which brings festival participants and the public together at our Showgrounds precinct.
