Some of Australia's most creative designers will return to the Brisbane Showgrounds from this Friday for the three day Finders Keepers Spring Summer markets.

More than 90 stalls featuring the works of local and interstate makers, designers and artists selling everything from hand-made ceramics to ethically made clothing, will line the Exhibition Building.

The Finders Keepers is a regular at the Brisbane Showgrounds, holding several markets a year since moving to the venue in 2016.

Apart from shopping and connecting with the creative stallholder community, guests will also enjoy local food trucks and a bar.

Brisbane Showgrounds General Manager of Venue Sales and Marketing Jago Coyle said they look forward to once again hosting the popular markets.

"The Finders Keepers Autumn Winter market in May was hugely successful and we look forward to Australia's leading design marketplace returning on Friday," Mr Coyle said.

"More than 10,000 people are expected to attend the three day event, including those treating Dad to a day out on Sunday for Father's Day."

Entry to the markets is \$5, with children under 12 years of age free. Doors open at 4pm on Friday and 9am on Saturday and Sunday.
