A wild start to the New Year for the Brisbane Showgrounds

One of Australia's largest single-day summer music festivals, Wildlands, will take over the Brisbane Showgrounds tomorrow.

More than 30,000 people are set to kick off New Year's Day at the event, with over 20 artists performing, including some of the world's biggest electronic, indie and hip-hop acts.

Australian GRAMMY-nominated DJ and producer Dom Dolla will headline the event, with US stars Addison Rae and rapper Kid Cudi also part of the stacked line-up, alongside Kettama, Chris Stussy, and more.

The artists will perform across three stages, including a new 360° 'in the round' stage featuring raised dance floors and a four-point sound system.

Brisbane Showgrounds General Manager of Venue Sales and Marketing Jago Coyle said Wildlands had been a highlight on the Brisbane Showgrounds calendar since 2019.

"We're excited to welcome Wildlands back to the Showgrounds, this year for the first time on New Year's Day instead of its usual New Year's Eve date," he said.

"We then continue our summer music schedule on January 30 with internationally renowned Australian rock band Ocean Alley."
