Theatre fans to cut loose at the Brisbane Showgrounds

They'll be dancing in the aisles when the theatre production of the 80s cult movie "Footloose" headlines the Royal International Convention Centre (Royal ICC) from this Friday (April 24).

After sold out performances in Adelaide the freshly remastered show Footloose the Musical based on the iconic film will take up residence at the Royal ICC for a two week season.

Showgoers will delight in performances of the hits they know and love "Holding Out For a Hero", "Almost Paradise", "Let's Hear It For the Boy" and of course the title track "Footloose".

Meet Ren, the city kid turned rebel with a cause, who rolls into a small town where music and dancing are banned, and sets out to change everything.

Packed with electrifying choreography, a feel-good story and sizzling Australian talent, the smash-hit musical will deliver two shows per day on the weekends and one show per day on the weekdays.

Brisbane Showgrounds General Manager of Venue Sales and Marketing Jago Coyle said they were excited to host Australia's first professional staging of Footloose in over 20 years.

"The Royal ICC will be transformed into a professional tiered seating theatre for a 10 day, 12 show season, demonstrating how versatile the Brisbane Showgrounds events precinct is," said Mr Coyle.
