Listen Out brings big crowds to the Brisbane Showgrounds

More than 40,000 festival-goers will pack the Brisbane Showgrounds tomorrow for Australia's premier dance music event Listen Out.

The line-up includes huge international names like American rapper Denzel Curry and American DJ Diplo, along with homegrown headliner Flume.

The artists will perform across three music stages, with the large-scale event utilising 10 major venue spaces at the Showgrounds including the Main Arena, Marquees 1 and 2 and The Pavilion.

Brisbane Showgrounds General Manager of Venue Sales and Marketing Jago Coyle said Listen Out was last held at the Showgrounds three years ago.

"The popular festival was held at our venue from 2014 to 2016 and we're thrilled to see it return this year," he said.

"Thanks to our inner city location and large variety of indoor and outdoor spaces, we provide the perfect backdrop for some of the best festivals in the country."

The Brisbane Showgrounds is a mecca for music festivals, with popular events RNB Fridays Live, Festival X, Good Things, Wildlands and FOMO all scheduled to take place at the venue this spring/summer festival season.

Listen Out will get underway at midday tomorrow.

The 22 hectare Brisbane Showgrounds precinct is located just 1.5km from Brisbane's CBD and is Queensland's largest indoor / outdoor events site.
