TOUCH BASS to elevate the Brisbane Showgrounds this Easter

The latest addition to the Brisbane Showgrounds' calendar of music festivals is Australia's premier bass music event TOUCH BASS, which will bring the energy to the inner city venue on Easter Saturday.

This Saturday 19 April, bass music lovers will pack the Brisbane Showgrounds for the powerhouse lineup of international and local artists currently touring Australia and New Zealand.

New to the Brisbane Showgrounds this year, the TOUCH BASS event will be headlined by Canada's Excision who is bringing his world acclaimed ANZ-AUDIO-VISUAL production to Australia for the first time.

Joining Excision is two of the UK's biggest drum and bass names Hedex & K Motionz, Austria's Camo & Krooked/MEFJUS; French bass phenomenon HOLI; UK vocalist Emily Makris and South London's MC P Money and San Diego's YDG.
