Shop secondhand over new at the Brisbane Showgrounds this weekend

The Brisbane Showgrounds will be home to a festival of recycled fashion and fun this weekend when Australia's biggest curated fashion market, Fashion Thrift Society, sets up shop.

Brisbane is the next stop for the country's largest fashion market bringing together independent sellers offering handpicked vintage and pre-loved items, alongside local brands and artisans. This year the event at the Showgrounds will run for two days on Saturday 5 and Sunday 6 April.

The Fashion Thrift Society event features everything from handmade clothing, jewellery-making stations and hair styling bars to photo booths, tarot readings and live DJ sets. Further creating a festival-like atmosphere will be a range of local food trucks and a licensed pop-up bar.

Fashion Thrift Society is calling all lovers of sustainable, vintage and second-hand fashion to come shop up a storm, armed with their reusable shopping bags.

Brisbane Showgrounds General Manager of Venue Sales and Marketing Jago Coyle said he was thrilled to see the Fashion Thrift Society return and expand their event from one to two days.

"The Fashion Thrift Society tour has become a juggernaut now visiting 19 Australian cities, so we are excited they have made their Brisbane stop at the Showgrounds a two day event this year," Mr Coyle said.

"Its unique offering of fashion, food and fun is clearly a winner with more and more people visiting the market each year and choosing to shop secondhand over new."
